

Rules at Sea

When sailing one must adhere to the proper codes of conduct.

- Employees and students must exercise their good judgment to avoid engaging in conduct that may reasonably be perceived by others as harassment.
- The ASAP will not protect a student from any disciplinary consequences that may arise from subsequent breaking of a school rule.
- The faculty expects students to focus attention on the academic program and work to their potential.
- The Academy will require the participation and cooperation of all non-victim students in a sexual misconduct investigation and disciplinary process conducted by the Academy, including the student accused of misconduct.
- The dean of students is in charge of the administration of faculty policy in all matters concerning student life, including discipline.
- Students who are Required to Withdraw may not return to campus for one year without the prior written approval of the Academy.
- Students receiving four unexcused absences within a term will be placed on Disciplinary Restrictions for two weeks.
