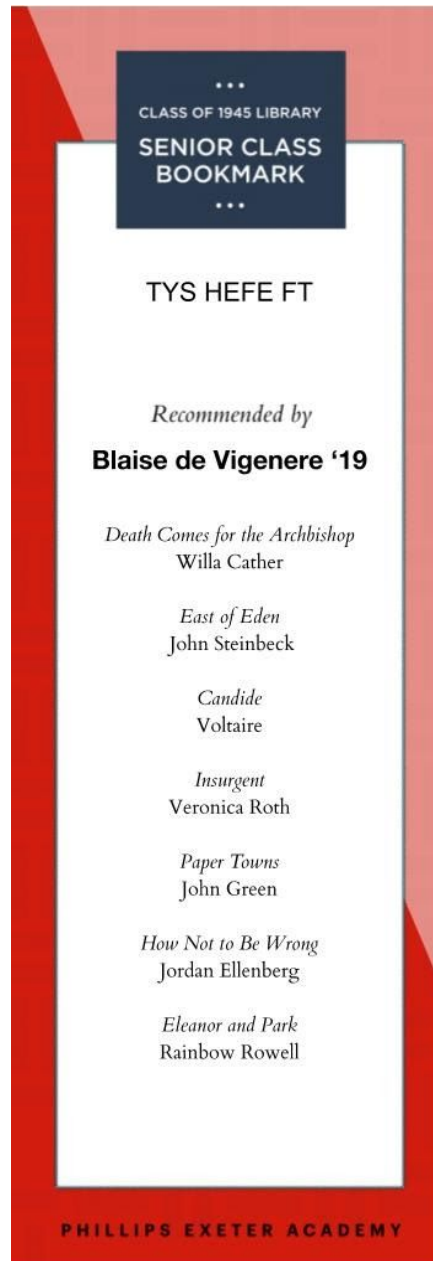


# Senior Bookmarks

Beware of suspicious aliases,

Flavortext says (in black) “beware of suspicious aliases” → each bookmark has one author with a pen name. Flavortext ends in comma, and in the following white text says “and read down the left side of titles.” Taking the first letter of each title gives: “DECIPHER WITH AUTHORS REAL SURNAME AS KEY.”

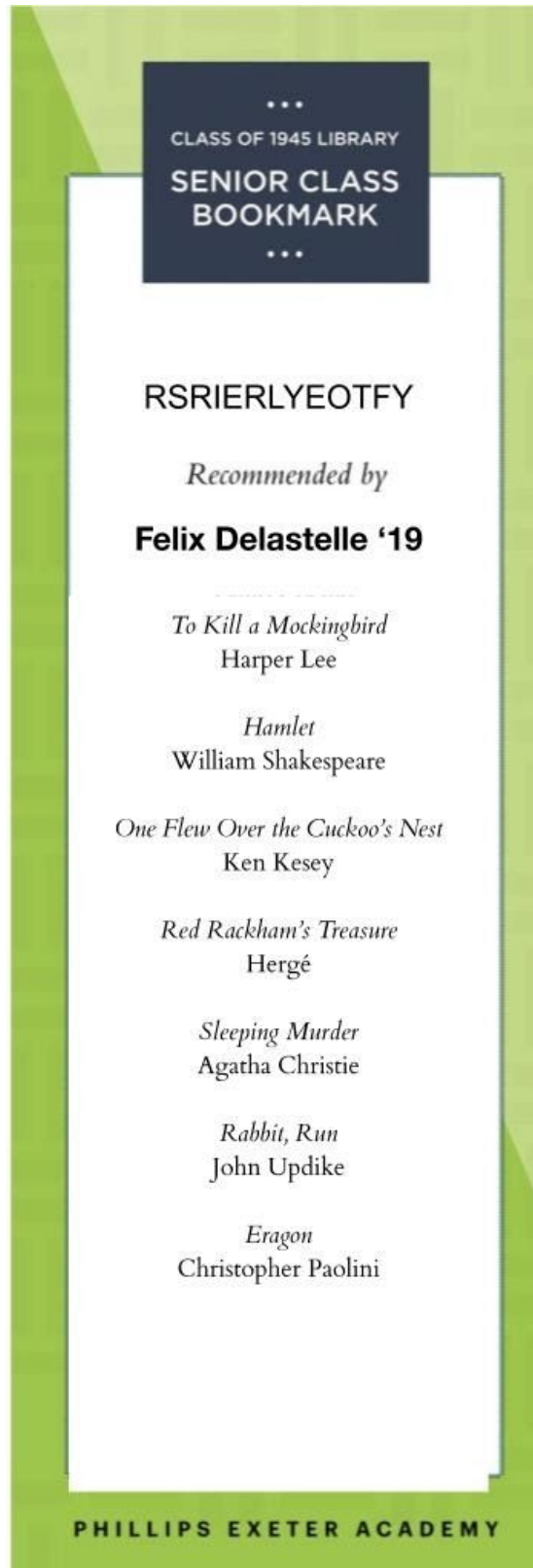

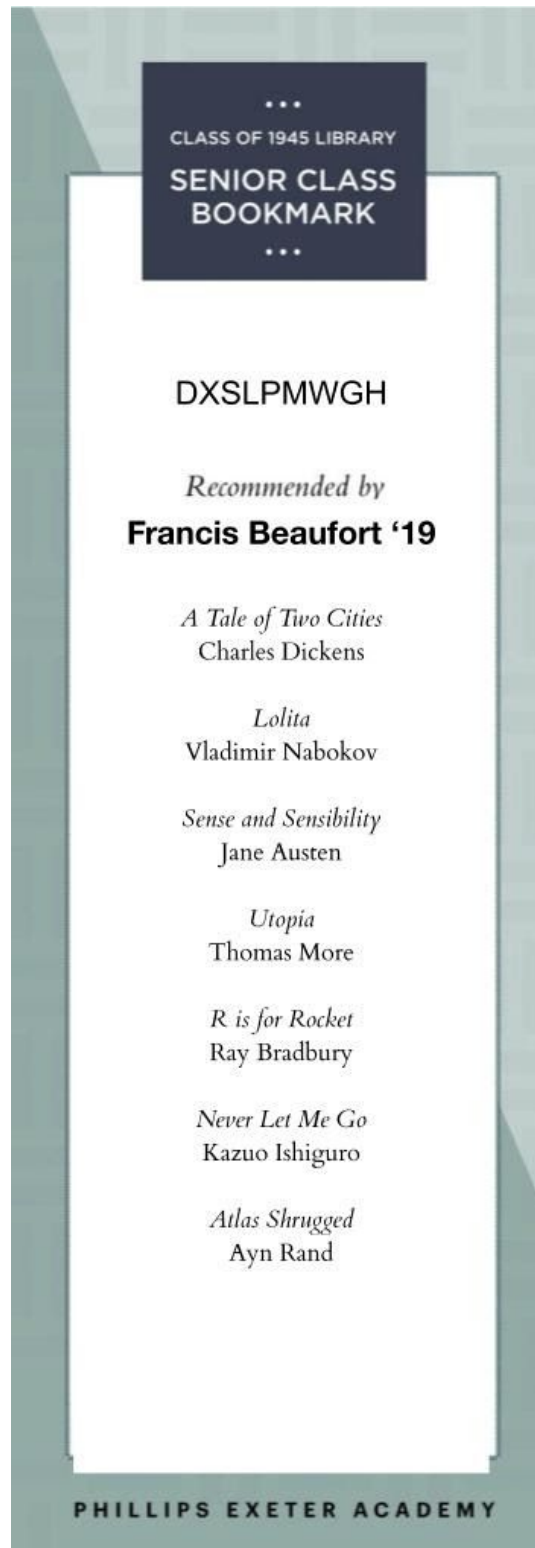
<sup>1</sup> Blaise de Vigenere → Vigenere Cipher. Deciphering TYS HEFE FT with key AROUET (Voltaire's surname) gives THE NAME OF



<sup>2</sup> Lyon Playfair → Playfair Cipher. Deciphering I BHNIM with BLAIR (Orwell's surname) gives A ROMAN.



<sup>3</sup> Felix Delastelle → Bifid Cipher. Deciphering RSRIERLYEOTFY with key REMI (Hergé's surname) gives MATHEMATICIAN

<sup>4</sup> Francis Beaufort → Beaufort Cipher. Deciphering DXSLPMWGH with key ROSENBAUM (Rand's surname) gives ORATYPEOF.

<sup>5</sup> Otto Key → Autokey Cipher. Deciphering EMDRADRH FQUD with key EVANS (Eliot's surname) gives ARDEIDAE BIRD.

Putting together the deciphered phrases gives: THE NAME OF A ROMAN MATHEMATICIAN  
OR A TYPE OF ARDEIDAE BIRD → **HERON**
