

## Birds go tweet

**ANSWER:** CHEEP

Use fieldmarks, range maps/noises, and/or Tineye to identify each kind of bird from the image groupings: Bar-Tailed Godwit, Black-Crowned Night Heron, Blue-Winged Warbler, Northern Waterthrush.

Title and flavor: "Birds go tweet" and "I can hear the birds twittering away. Can you help me account for which each is?" → the birds correspond to Twitter accounts. Look up each bird name and there *\*should\** just be one account that goes with it.

Once you find the accounts, each has a bunch of numbers with clues. In the bio, each has "horizontal" or "vertical." These indicate across and down crossword clues.

Fill out the crossword. Some of the clues and answers are a little questionable/funky but working on the assumption that people are solving in a puzzle hunt way, not in a newspaper crossword way, they should be able to get at least the vast majority of them.

Once you've filled out the crossword, the second "copy" below has numbers in certain boxes. Find the letters in those boxes, then see what it spells out = "bargain bird noise" → phonetics/cryptic/whatever is "cheap" → CHEEP
