## Solution to A Crossword - Take One

## (Puzzle by Vinjai Vale and Matt Hambacher)

## Answer: HICCUP

The first step is to realize that all of the given clues are one letter too short to fit in the crossword grid. Then one notices that the unlabeled clues at the end correspond to the labeled ones, except with the missing letter added back in (e.g. "Not really" and "Big boat builder", which clue NAH and NOAH respectively - thus the "Take One" in the puzzle title). Filling in all the clues and ordering them according to the unlabeled ones yields:

The down clues spell NOT HERE NILTDCHPILRSILPSLOS, which suggests looking at the across clues instead. This is further motivated by "A Crossword" in the title being reinterpreted as "Across Word".

The across clues spell ANSWER IS HITCFCUOP TAKE. Following the TAKE ONE idea from the title, we remove three letters from HITCFUOP and obtain the word HICCUP, which is the final answer - and which also happens to be a term for a "take" gone badly, once more circling back to the title.
