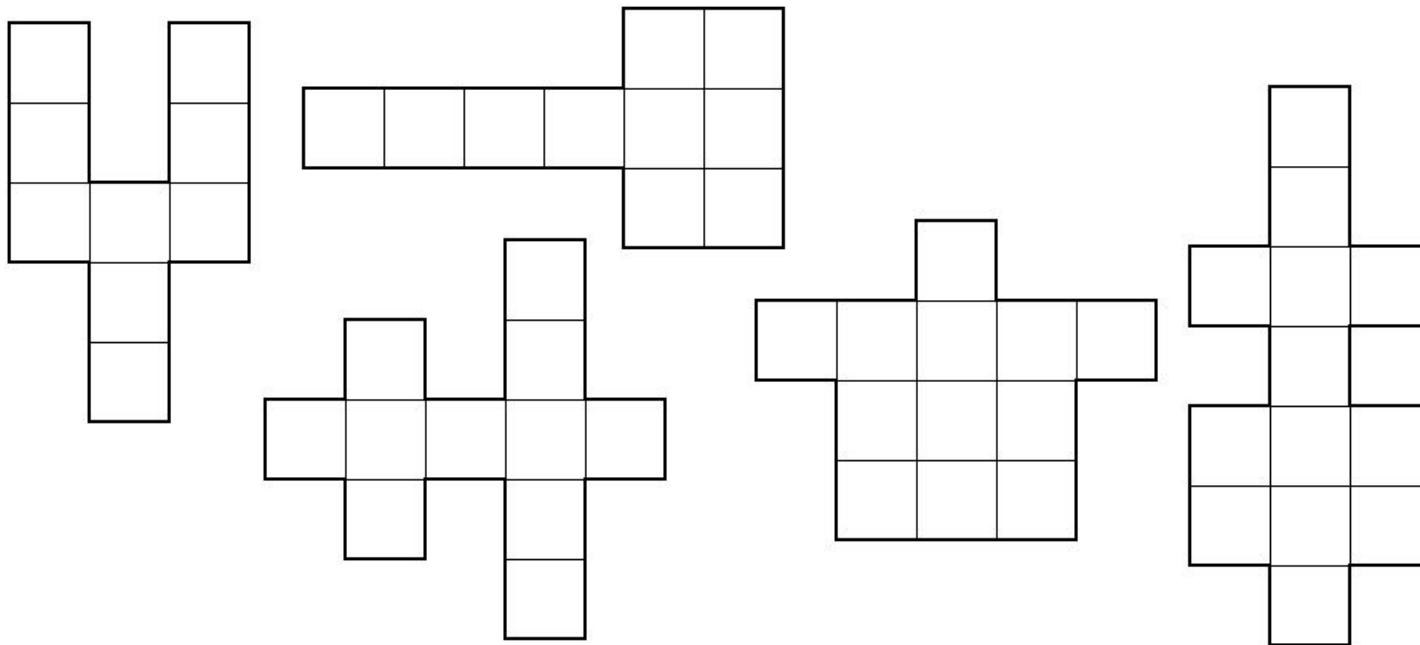


Meta Meta
